Instructions: Cut along solid lines, fold at dashed lines.

<p>Penny: 1 cent Abraham Lincoln, 16th President Lincoln Memorial</p>	
<p>Nickel: 5 cents. Thomas Jefferson, 3rd President Monticello, his home in Charlottesville, VA</p>	
<p>Dime: 10 cents Franklin D Roosevelt, 32nd President Torch — symbol of freedom Olive & oak branches — peace & victory</p>	
<p>Quarter: 25 cents George Washington, 1st President Spread-winged Eagle or the front of the U.S. Seal</p>

Instructions: Cut along solid lines, fold at dashed lines.

<p>50-cent piece John F Kennedy, 35th President US. Seal</p>	
<p>Dollar Coin: \$1 Dwight D. Eisenhower. Minted from 1971 to 1978. All other years are minted with pictures of other presidents.</p>	
<p>President on \$1 one dollar bill: George Washington George Washington is also on quarter dollar coin.</p>	
<p>President on \$2 two dollar bill: Thomas Jefferson Thomas Jefferson is also on a nickel coin.</p>

Instructions: Cut along solid lines, fold at dashed lines.

President on \$5 five dollar bill: Abraham Lincoln

Abraham Lincoln is also on a cent/penny..



Face on \$10 Ten dollar bill: Alexander Hamilton. He was not a president.




President on \$20 twenty dollar bill:

president.

Benjamin Franklin was featured on half-
dollar coin.



President on \$500 five hundred dollar bill:
William McKinley

William McKinley was featured on gold

President on \$1,000 one thousand dollar
bill: Grover Cleveland
